You are encouraged to register right away using the MERIT BADGE SELECTIONS AND REGISTRATION FORM. Select 1 merit badge from the list per class period this is your first choice badge. Then write in 2 alternate merit badges per period. Please do not repeat the alternate badges you list. By providing two different alternates per period you will be helping us make sure you get to take the badges you want. Every effort will be made to give you your first choice.

Your scoutmaster will help you with your selections and his signature is required on the registration form. Most merit badges will require homework. There are some merit badges, such as Family Life and Personal Management which have a 90 day requirement. Partials can be completed within your troop.

The registration fee until the February 6th Roundtable is \$20 per scout and includes three merit badge booklets and a participation patch. Late registrations, received after February 6th are \$30. No registrations will be accepted after February 22nd.

All Scouts must wear their CLASS "A" UNIFORM. Bring a notebook and pencil/pen and come prepared to pay attention in class and give every courtesy to the adult volunteers.
